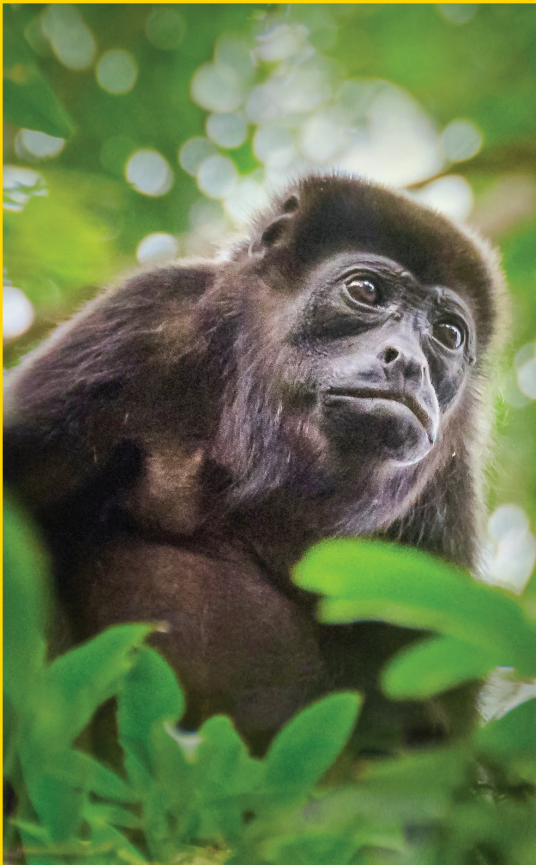

- Discover the storied Spanish architecture and fascinating pirate history of Portobelo, a UNESCO World Heritage site.
- Meet the Indigenous Emberá people of Darién in Playa Muerto Village and learn about their customs, traditions and deep reverence for their natural surroundings.
- Sea kayak, hike, Zodiac cruise and snorkel in the tranquil Pearl Islands, a network of 200 isles known for turquoise waters, white-sand beaches and an enduring connection to the pearl trade.

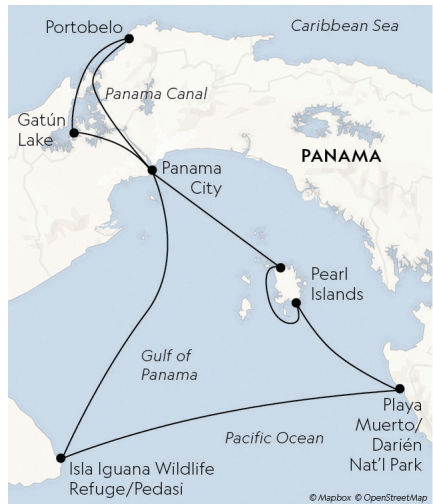

Panama is world-renowned for its iconic canal, a groundbreaking achievement in engineering—but you'll find that the country holds a wealth of other discoveries just beyond the concrete walls of this manmade marvel. Encounter monkeys, iguanas, tropical birds and more, and snorkel coral reefs that shelter an array of colorful marine life.

You'll explore Spanish colonial military architecture in Portobelo and hear tales of the local pirate history. You'll meet with village leaders of the Emberá people in Darién, and kayak in the remote Pearl Islands, where you'll learn about the archipelago's enduring connections to the pearl trade. This eight-day voyage lets you discover untamed tropical wilderness and a historic engineering feat with enduring global significance.

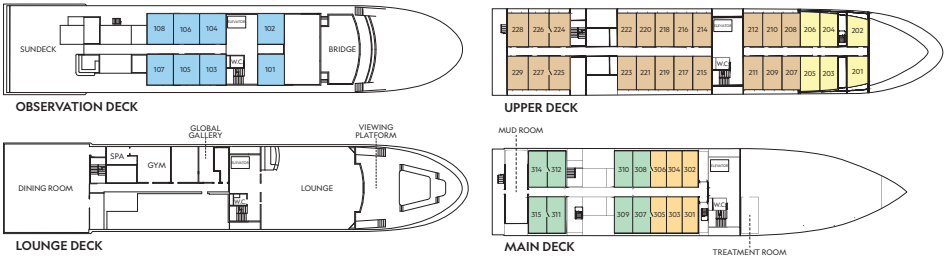
