Sail to the high Arctic archipelago of Svalbard, one of the best places on the planet to see polar bears in their native habitat. In addition to polar bears, we'll be on the lookout for walrus, reindeer, elusive arctic foxes, fur seals and numerous species of birds. The archipelago offers unique hikes, with artful, sculptural arrangements of whale bones on pebbled beaches and the ghostly remains of trappers' huts.

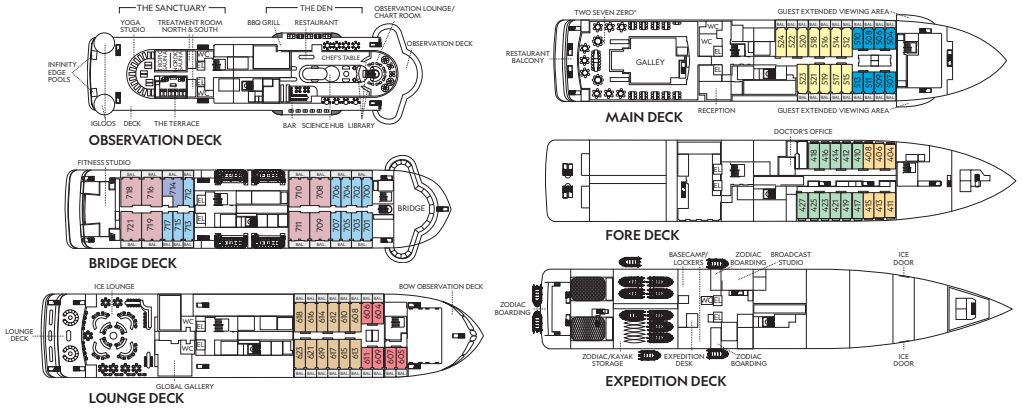
